Proceeds from the biennial event will fund EWNJ's scholarship program, which has provided over \$1 million in scholarships to more than 300 deserving New Jersey women enrolled in advanced degree programs at New Jersey institutions since implementing the program in 1986, as well as other programs that advance women. New Jersey Resources (NJR) Chairman of the Board and CEO Laurence M. Downes serves as the event's honorary dinner chair. Elaine Chao, former United States Secretary of Labor, will serve as guest speaker for the event.
